# 2024 | Our Impact

A \$75,000 Matching Gift Campaign with the Surrey Food Bank that reached its goal in three days. Over \$108,000 additional funds were donated. A **\$50,000 Matching Gift Campaign** with **Covenant House Vancouver** that generated **4,757 gifts** to Covenant House Vancouver and **raised \$768,169**.

Hosted a holiday lunch for over 575 Surrey teachers.

Added **three** new schools to the **Bright Futures Foundation partnership**, for a total of **nine**. Worked with the **BC Cancer Society** to host a fundraising event that had over **100 donors** and dignitaries attend.

Supported the High-Performance Cardiac Rehabilitation Research program through SportsCardiologyBC – the first and only of its kind in Canada. This program helps a multidisciplinary group diagnose and treat heart problems in athletes and physically active people before their lives are endangered.

Partnered with the Surrey School District to launch the **Bright Futures Foundation: Empowering Schools, Enriching Lives.** This initiative provides essential financial support to schools in Surrey and White Rock and focuses on creating innovative programs that foster academic excellence while promoting students' personal development and well-being.
